



## Community Investment Classifications

- **Youth Development – Attributes:** Character building, Delinquency Prevention and Improved attitudes and performance
- **Seniors and Self-Sufficiency – Attributes:** Improve/maintain the ability to function safely in their home. Decrease isolation.
- **Skill Building and Access to Services – Attributes:** Increase skills, knowledge and access to community services. Experience enhanced safety, economic and social stability. Make a meaningful contribution to the community.
- **Family Services – Attributes:** Improve family functioning. Demonstrate a reduction of conflict. Experience improved family-life conditions.
- **Basic Needs – Attributes:** Successfully resolve an immediate crisis and move toward safety and stability.
- **Crisis Program – Attributes:** Reduction of conflict. Prevention of abuse.
- **Capacity Building and Innovation – Attributes:** Strategic and operational advancement. New and creative programs responding to identified community need.
